5. Teams will be grouped on geographical location wherever possible.

### **U7**

1. U7 girls will play on Sundays, U7 boys will play on Saturdays.
2. Games commence on the weekend of October 28, 2017.
3. Entry into the CMSA Minifest, - February 24, 2018.
4. Members entered into the CMSA league can order player jerseys from Shane Homes for all teams at no additional cost.

### U11

3. U12 Tiers I – IV may play any day of the week  
U12 Tier V will play on Sundays and Wednesdays.  
U12 Tier VI will play on Saturdays and Mondays.
4. Tier I – VI will participate in a Pre-Season. At the end of the Pre-Season, Members may move teams they believe have been misplaced. Teams will then participate in a Regular Season. At the end of the Regular Season the top teams will advance to their appropriate Post Season Play. Formats will depend on the number of teams entered.
5. Post Season Play:
